

Notice of Race
2008 All J and J-24 District Championship Regatta
August 16-17, 2008

1. Host

The regatta will be hosted by **Oswego Yacht Club**. Oswego Yacht Club is located in the Oswego International Marina on Lake St.

2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the 2005-2008 *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.

3. Entry and Fees

The regatta is open to all J Boats and properly registered J-24 and J-22 boats. The OYC organizing authority must be in receipt of the completed registration form and entry fee for \$80 (US or CN) less 5.00 for US Sailing members by August 1, 2008. Any registrations after that date must pay \$100 for entry. Onsite registration will be 3-9 P.M. on Friday and 7:30-8:30 A.M. Saturday. 4. Insurance, Inspection and Measurement

Proof of insurance for property damage, and third party liability coverage is required for all participants. J-24 participants are required to carry a current measurement certificate and current J-24 class membership number. J-24's without valid measurement certificates may be measured by prior appointment only. J-24s should be prepared to be weighed (all up sailing weight 1345 kg) prior to launching.

5. Launching and Rafting

Launching and docking will be provided for all out-of-town boats adjacent to the Wrights Landing public marina on Lake Street. Competing boats will be launched by 9:00 a.m. August 16, and will remain in the water with rudders affixed for the duration of the regatta unless prior written approval to haul is obtained by regatta officials. J-24's are subject to inspection by regatta officials at any time during the regatta.

6. Skippers Meeting

Skippers meeting will commence at 0830 August 16 at the OYC clubhouse deck, with racing on Lake Ontario's open waters to begin as soon as practical thereafter.

7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at check-in and include course and mark descriptions.

8. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the RRS will apply. Several races are scheduled. There will be a throw out when and if six races are completed. Two completed races shall constitute a regatta.
